We are looking for Leadership Interns to help make our program a success and this volunteer position is ideal for high school and college students seeking to build leadership skills through formalized training and practical experience.



- Scholars are not permitted to bring outside food in (other than bringing their lunch to school, or a classroom lunch activity, which is led by their teacher). If they have to eat lunch outside of the normal lunchtime, they are permitted to eat in the office.
- Please make yourself aware of activities going on at your scholar's home high school. We have scholars from many different home high schools, which makes it very hard to know what's going on at each.
- If your scholar is getting their drivers permit, a "No Pass No Drive" form needs to be filled out. You can get those from your scholar's home high school.

- If your scholar is out for an EHO, they are not to be in the building to catch a ride with another scholar.
